Sunday's Series Finale Cancelled

IOWA CITY, Iowa – Due to the winter snowstorm that has hit Iowa City and the Midwest, Sunday's series finale against 11th-ranked Indiana has been cancelled.

The Hawkeyes and Hoosiers split a Friday doubleheader. Indiana won the series opener, 4-2, before Iowa rode the arm of junior Brady Schanuel to a 5-1 win to earn the split. Schanuel struck out a career-high 11 Hoosiers over seven innings. Iowa (13-8, 1-1) returns to action Wednesday, hosting Bradley at 4:05 p.m. (CT) at Duane Banks Field

Chris Bono named Wisconsin wrestling head coach

Big 12 Coach of the Year engineered turnaround as South Dakota State head coach

MADISON, Wis. – Chris Bono, the 2017 Big 12 Coach of the Year, has been named the 16th head coach in Wisconsin wrestling history, Director of Athletics Barry Alvarez announced Saturday.

Bono spent the last six seasons as the head coach at South Dakota State, establishing the Jackrabbits as a national contender and a powerhouse in the Big 12, coaching three conference champions in the program's three years in the league.

The Jackrabbits are coming off their best season under Bono. Two-time All-American Seth Gross won the program's first national title at 133 pounds while the team placed 12th in the NCAA tournament, the highest finish of any Big 12 team.

Bono has coached five All-Americans at South Dakota State, including three from last season. He produced two the year before, marking the first All-Americans for South Dakota State at the Division I level. Bono had at least one NCAA Qualifier since taking the reins of the program and had a school-record seven in the most recent tournament.

Bono leaves SDSU with a 64-41 overall record, a total of 24 NCAA qualifiers, five All-Americans and one national champion.

A four-time NCAA qualifier and three-time All-American for Iowa State, Bono ranks fifth in ISU history with 130 career wins and was the 150-pound NCAA champion as a junior. He went on to coach as an assistant at his alma mater for nine years and was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2002.

Bono then spent three seasons as the head coach at Chattanooga and led the Mocs to three Southern Conference titles, coaching two All-Americans and 19 NCAA qualifiers from 2006-09.

In national and international competition, Bono is a two-time United States National Champion, took first at the World Cup in both 2002 and 2003 and is a three-time World Team member. Mishawaka sophomore Paishence Johnson on her 60 meter dash 3rd place in HSR Relays Finals @ IU!

Crossroads League in the NAIA National Polls | March 19-25

KANSAS CITY – The NAIA released a new batch of Top-25 Polls this week for the sports of baseball and golf. The Crossroads League placed seven teams in those polls and currently boasts a total of 34 teams ranked or receiving votes.

BASEBALL (*Announced on March 20 - Next Poll on April 3*)

RV Taylor (23-7, 3-2 CL) held steady in the second Top-25 Poll of the regular season, earning 64 points. The Trojans currently rate No. 4 in the NAIA with 2.7 steals per game, No. 6 with a .971 fielding percentage and No. 6 with a 2.90 earned-run average.

WOMEN'S GOLF (*Announced on March 23 - Next Poll on April 6*)

No. 17 Taylor dropped two spots in the new women's golf Top-25 Poll. TU grabbed 242 points in the poll and opened its spring season on March 22 and 23 with a win at the seven-team Purgatory Intercollegiate.

No. 25 Bethel held onto the final spot in the Top-25 with 106 points. BC has yet to take the course this spring and will open play on March 26.

RV Marian just missed a Top-25 rating with 89 points and the 26th-highest total in the poll. The Knights scored team wins in each of their first two spring outings.

RV Indiana Wesleyan took 29 points in the latest poll. The Wildcats have played in one event this spring, finishing fourth-of-eight.

MEN'S GOLF (*Announced on March 23 - Next Poll on April 6*)

No. 13 Taylor did not change spots in the newest ratings and earned 299 points. TU has opened its spring campaign with a 23-4 head-to-head mark in two outings, finishing fourth-of-14 and second-of-15. RV Indiana Wesleyan jumped into the national rankings by receiving 14 votes. IWU opened its spring season with a seventh-place showing at the 15-team Purgatory Invite hosted by Taylor.

FORT WAYNE, Ind. – Fort Wayne baseball fell to North Dakota State 15-0 on Saturday (March 24) on a sub-40 degree day at Mastodon Field.

NDSU scored one in the first and two in the second to open up the scoring. A three-run third-inning provided additional run support for starter Blake Stockert (2-1). Stockert went six innings for the win for NDSU. Jayse McLean had three hits and three runs scored for the Bison.

Fort Wayne recorded 10 hits in the game. Jack Lang and Jacob Dickson each had two hits for the 'Dons. Fort Wayne had scoring chances but stranded runners in six of the seven innings. Damian Helm (2-4) suffered the loss after 2.1 innings of work. Fort Wayne falls to 4-14 (0-5 Summit League). NDSU is now 10-11 (3-2 Summit League). Fort Wayne and NDSU will play on Sunday (March 25) at 1 p.m. at Mastodon Field.
