**MARION, Ind.** – Indiana Wesleyan University volleyball won all four matches this weekend at the IWU Invitational to improve to 12-10 this season. IWU defeated Trinity International (Ill.) and Saint Francis (Ill.) on Saturday, both in three sets. IWU has now won six straight matches and 10 of their last 11.
