

## Pilots Split Day Two of Crossover; Earn First Win of Season

**PALOS HEIGHTS, Ill.** – The Bethel College Pilots women’s volleyball team finished the SXU/TCC Crossover on Saturday afternoon and came away with a split on day two, earning their first win against Roosevelt (Ill.) before dropping a thrilling five-set match to Judson to end the day. Payton Anderson and Kassandra Williams continued their stellar play for the Pilots, as Anderson notched a triple double against Goshen and Kassandra Williams totaled 25 kills on the day.

- Payton Anderson notched her first triple double since September 8, 2017 against Goshen with 46 assists, 10 kills, and 10 digs against Judson—the third triple double of her career. Her 46 assists are a season-high.
- Kassandra Williams has at least 12 kills in four of the six matches this season and currently owns a .341 hitting percentage on the season. Her .571 hitting percentage against Judson is her highest in a match since October 28, 2015 against Spring Arbor.
- The Pilots matched a season-high with 63 kills against Judson and finished one shy of their season-high in assists with 62. Both season-highs were set against No. 20 Madonna on August 16.
